RM240,000 armed robbery: Man claims trial

KUALA LUMPUR: An employee of a recycling company Monday pleaded not guilty in the Sessions Court to a charge of committing armed robbery involving RM243,920 two years ago.

R. Kunasekaran, 27, was charged, with four others still at large, with committing gang robbery with macheles at a licensed money changer at the Tesco Manjalara Kepong shopping centre here on Nov 26, 2013.

Judge Azman Ahmad granted Kunasekaran bail of RM10,000 on condition that he did not interfere with witnesses, surrendered his passport to the court and reported himself to the nearest police station every month.

Deputy public prosecutor Siti Aishyah (rpt) Aishyah Ahmad had objected to bail, saying the offence was a serious

However, Kunasekaran's counsel V. Muniandy sought ball, saying that his client had to support a wife who was not working.

The court set Feb 27 for mention of the case. - Bernama
